Improvement works at Swanson Dock East

Port of Melbourne and Patrick Terminals would like to advise of impending wharf remediation and improvement works at Swanson Dock East Berth 1.

The project will involve the replacement of existing timber pilings along the berth, in conjunction with rail replacement works, deck resurfacing and fender remediation.

The works will be conducted in two stages, from July 2017 through to June 2018, to minimise any potential disruption.

The initial stage - from the 0 to 90 metres mark - will see works conducted between July and December 2017.

The second stage - from the 90 metres mark to 255 metres mark.

During this period and to minimise berthing delays at the terminal, Port of Melbourne and Patrick Terminals are committed to ensuring that vessel turn around times remain as efficient as possible. The timing of this second stage of works will be confirmed closer to commencement.

The project forms part of the Port's objective to deliver world class, safe and reliable port facilities and services vital in delivering an efficient freight supply chain to support Victoria's growing economy, together with the efficient movement of goods within Melbourne and regional Victoria.
